Dear Supporters,

This past year has been unlike any other in City Harvest's history. We sensed immediately that the consequences of bank failures would reach far beyond Wall Street, with definite repercussions for City Harvest and our agency partners. Indeed, New York City felt some of the first shocks of the economic collapse, as losses in the financial industry cascaded throughout the economy. Over the course of the year, the unemployment rate in New York City nearly doubled. From July's rate of 5 percent, unemployment crept to more than 7 percent in December, then over 8 percent in February, finally reaching nearly 10 percent by the close of our fiscal year – with more increases to come.

Many of our agency partners were already experiencing food shortages when Lehman Brothers filed for bankruptcy in September of 2008. In this new unstable economy, they faced a full-fledged crisis, as an economic emergency called for more emergency food. City Harvest and the programs where we deliver food became responsible for feeding many of the people who found themselves suddenly out of work, as they joined low-income families and senior citizens living on fixed incomes in food pantry and soup kitchen lines. We began to receive emails and phone calls from people directly reaching out for help, asking where they could find food. It was clear that these were people who weren't used to seeking help.

City Harvest faced the local consequences of a global recession. We took immediate action, meeting to brainstorm ideas around how we could stretch our resources to deliver more food and support agencies. Even as we faced greater challenges ourselves in raising food and funds, City Harvest delivered 27 million pounds of food – 5 million more than the previous year – to help relieve hunger in New York City.

More than 40,000 financial donors made it possible for City Harvest to take on a leadership role to support the individuals, families, and communities hit hardest by the recession. The New York Community Trust and Goldman Sachs Gives, The New York Times Neediest Cases Fund, the Leona M. Helmsley Charitable Trust, and other funders came forward in the fall and winter with over \$750,000 in grants dedicated to emergency food. In the spring, Credit Suisse, along with our board of directors and event co-chairs, underwrote An Evening of Practical Magic, which raised \$1 million in support of City Harvest. The recession helped City Harvest strengthen existing partnerships and create new ones. In December, the Daily News Readers Care to Feed the Hungry food drive raised a record-breaking 938,000 pounds of food, and in June, over 200 agency directors met to share best practices for meeting the increased need for emergency food at our First Annual Agency Conference.

No one could have anticipated that this year New York City and the United States would confront the worst economic contraction since the Great Depression. City Harvest was the recipient of unparalleled generosity and compassion for those most affected. We are truly thankful to all of our supporters who made our work possible when we were most needed. If any time called for City Harvest to go full throttle to feed New York City, it was this past year.

FUELING OUR WORK

From its very start, City Harvest knew it would be critical to our operations to track the recession's impact on hunger's front lines. Almost immediately we began reaching out to a group of representative agencies on a monthly basis to learn how drastic economic changes were affecting them on the ground. Throughout the course of the year, we learned that all of the agency partners we surveyed were seeing more people because of joblessness and higher costs of living – and more disturbingly, that about half were seeing new faces.

In a time of scant resources, it became especially important to put food donations to strategic use. Over 3 million of the 27 million pounds of food we delivered over the course of the year were part of a special emergency initiative, funded in part by The New York Community Trust and Goldman Sachs Gives, The New York Times Neediest Cases Fund and The Leona M. and Harry B. Helmsley Charitable Trust, to push more food out to agencies where need was greatest. By monitoring the number of clients agencies were serving and how fast that number was growing, City Harvest was able to identify a core group of some 60 agencies where demand for food most outpaced its supply, and then targeted deliveries of this additional food to them.

It's one of our basic beliefs at City Harvest that economic hardship shouldn't force people to rely on cheap but unhealthy food. We have focused on sourcing more nutritious food for our agencies throughout the crisis, and the food we rescued continued to meet our high standards for nutrition. Close to 90 percent of the food we rescued over the past year was nutrient-dense, and fresh produce made up over 60 percent of our poundage. Over 2.8 million pounds of food reached kosher agencies, including 427,000 pounds of food for Passover – more than double our goal.

City Harvest recognized that agencies facing greater demand would need help increasing their capacity to provide meals and pantry bags. Held in June 2009 in partnership with Community Resource Exchange and made possible by funding from The New York Community Trust and Goldman Sachs Gives, City Harvest's Agency Conference was open to executive directors of emergency feeding programs within the five boroughs. Over 200 agency directors gathered to learn practical strategies to engage volunteers, budget in hard times, build strategic alliances, and plan for succession.





FINDING THE SHORTEST DISTANCE

In addition to increased food deliveries, the recession demanded that food reach people faster and with greater efficiency. With an eye toward directing maximum resources towards rescuing more food, City Harvest continued the process of greening our truck fleet by converting an additional six trucks to hybrid technology. City Harvest also obtained a truck routing and tracking system from UPS, made possible by a grant from Feeding America, to help us find the shortest distance between food donor and recipient.

Looking for more food close to home also enhanced our efficiency. By expanding relationships with local food donors, we were able to decrease transportation costs. In addition to stepping up efforts to find brand-new local sources within the five boroughs, City Harvest upped the number of days we pick up food from one of our current large donors, Hunts Point Terminal Produce Market. Over one million pounds of fresh produce from regional farmers helped feed hungry New Yorkers thanks to HarvestWorks, and our Produce Corners, which offered fresh food from the New York State region, became a regular feature at City Harvest's Mobile Markets.

To further enhance efficiency, we put some of our small donors on bike routes. Food businesses in Manhattan averaging donations of less than 100 pounds began to get regular visits from City Harvest cargo bikes starting in August. As a result, we were able to take a truck off the road in Manhattan, routing it to the outer boroughs for larger pick-ups instead. By transferring these donors to bike routes, City Harvest was able to consolidate our truck routes and still rescue every available pound of food.

New Yorkers also gave their time to ensure that large donations of food following events didn't go to waste, including more than 167,000 cans of high-quality food at the close of Canstruction. Thanks to Barclays' employees and many others, City Harvest was able to deliver over 205,000 pounds of premium food, much of it highly perishable, to soup kitchens and food pantries following the Fancy Food Show.



THE VEHICLE FOR NEW YORK'S GENEROSITY

Even throughout the recession, City Harvest remained a link between New Yorkers in need of food and generous neighbors with the resources to feed them. The corporate community, many of whom were hit hard by the economy, continued to lend strong support to City Harvest in whatever way they could. Over the holidays, BlackRock called City Harvest to donate 1,000 high-end meals prepared by Cipriani, starting a trend among companies that decided to forgo seasonal celebrations and to help feed others instead.

Driven by reports of increased need for food, New Yorkers were determined to make this year's Daily News Readers Care to Feed the Hungry food drive a banner year. Police stations, firehouses, schools, and thousands of individuals, companies and organizations joined forces to collect 938,000 pounds of nonperishable food – over 150,000 more pounds than the prior year, and a Daily News food drive record – to stock shelves at food pantries and soup kitchens. New York celebrities like Rachael Ray and Tyra Banks ran special food drives with their studio audiences, even securing extra bulk donations of healthy canned vegetables and fresh chicken to feed hungry individuals and families in the five boroughs. In the spring, City Harvest collected over 170,000 pounds of kid-friendly food for our Feed the Kids drive, thanks in large part to the efforts of New York City public schools, D'Agostino Supermarkets, Beech-nut Nutrition Corporation and Tropicana.

A surge of good will continued to inspire our volunteers, even in a difficult economic climate. Volunteers bagged produce at our Mobile Markets, taught nutrition education courses, and helped us fundraise by stuffing envelopes. Without volunteer support, City Harvest would not have been able to rescue over 478,000 pounds of fresh, local produce from Greenmarkets. Companies like Target not only helped fill our Mobile Market tables with produce by funding distributions, they helped staff them.

Events remained a key part of our fundraising efforts this year. We're thankful that David Arquette was able to help City Harvest honor 12 extraordinary guests at An Evening of Practical Magic, where Rob Thomas gave a heartfelt performance produced by Adam Shankman and Marc Shaiman. Credit Suisse and our board of directors underwrote the event, helping us raise \$1 million in support of City Harvest at a critical time, as donors knew that 100% of the cost of their tickets went to feeding hungry New Yorkers.



DELIVERING A BETTER FUTURE

Thanks to donor support, over the past year City Harvest was able to provide significant hunger relief while continuing to address the more complex issues that surround hunger. Our first priority was meeting the increased need for food we were seeing on the front lines at emergency feeding programs, but we never lost sight of efforts to deliver a better future that would last beyond the recession, including programs to build sustainable access to fresh produce in low-income communities and teach families to make nutritious choices.

Two age groups – children and seniors – continued to make up a growing segment of the people we serve. The road to a healthy lifestyle begins early, and this year, City Harvest's Fruit Bowl reached more than 2,100 children at day care and afterschool centers by providing nutritious snacks like fresh fruit, lowfat milk, and 100% juice. For Well Seasoned, nutritionists continued development of a nutrition education curriculum specific to the needs of older New Yorkers living on limited resources. This included working with a financial consultant to incorporate materials and activities to help seniors learn to eat well on a budget. Cooking clubs formed by seniors who have completed Well Seasoned currently meet regularly at senior centers, with City Harvest providing shares of local farm food for the clubs.

Our signature Healthy Neighborhoods program works to improve the access people have to nutritious food, especially fresh produce, in target low-income communities where diet-related diseases such as obesity and diabetes are common and to provide nutrition education and other resources residents need to eat well. Through Mobile Markets, we distributed over 430,000 pounds of free fresh produce to residents of New York City Housing Authority (NYCHA) buildings in Melrose in the Bronx and Stapleton, Staten Island over the past year. City Harvest also began a partnership with NYC Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to expand their Healthy Bodegas Initiative, helping develop evaluation tools used to gather information about the perception of bodegas and healthy food in target low-income communities and beginning a series of cooking demonstrations in which volunteers teach residents to prepare nutritious food with ingredients found in local bodegas.

City Harvest has also seen how critical it is to create positive change in policy around hunger. With other like-minded New Yorkers, City Harvest is advocating for legislative changes that will result in feeding more kids better food. Even though they are the children most at risk of hunger, one third of children fed at emergency feeding programs in New York City do not receive free or reduced-price school lunch and only about half get school breakfast. By spearheading the NYC Alliance for Child Nutrition Reauthorization, City Harvest began work with other organizations and individuals in New York City to ask our members of Congress to make needed changes to the Child Nutrition Act.





THE ROAD AHEAD

Strong relationships with donors, a history of innovation, and deep ties within the community positioned City Harvest to respond immediately at a time of record demand for emergency food. While we are proud of our ability to meet the challenges of the past year, the recession also pointed to the need for long-term solutions to ensure agencies are able to meet the needs of their clients on an ongoing basis. Understanding that the communities we serve are partners in the development of solutions that are unique to their needs, over the past year City Harvest has performed on-the-ground research to develop a more complete understanding of hunger and its underlying causes.

City Harvest collaborated with the Food Bank For New York City on local research efforts for Feeding America's Hunger in America, a national survey of the needs of people served by emergency feeding programs, collecting data from nearly 300 agencies and hundreds of clients to inform findings in the 2009 New York City report. We also partnered with the community in Stapleton, Staten Island to identify obstacles to healthy eating and strategies to improve access to nutritious food. Findings will be released as a Community Food Assessment in the coming year and will inform future Healthy Neighborhoods efforts in that community.

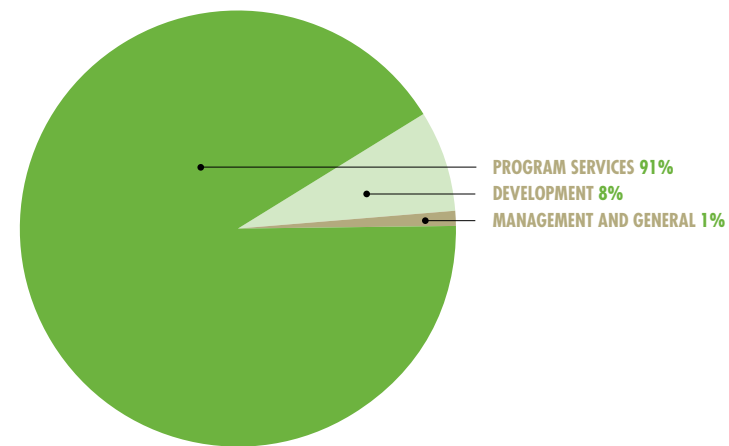
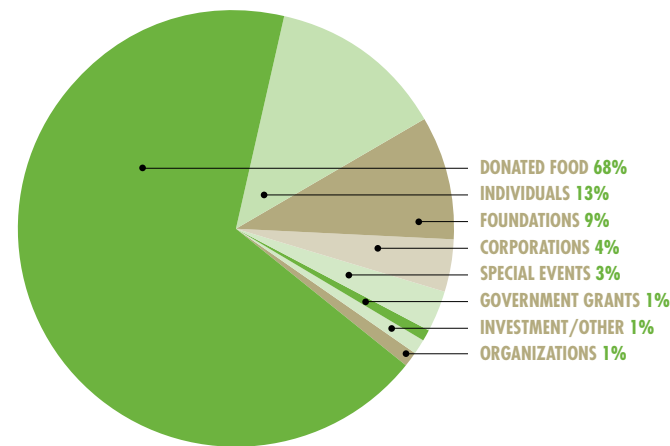
As convener for the NYC Food and Fitness Partnership, City Harvest led the creation of a Community Action Plan designed to transform school food systems, improve community food environments, and promote active living and routine physical activity. New York City is one of nine community locations funded by the W.K. Kellogg Foundation through a multi-year grant, and over the next three years, City Harvest will work with community groups to sustain and expand the growing national movement for healthy food and active living. While the policy and systems changes will reach all of NYC, the specific geography we are focusing on is in central Brooklyn. W.K. Kellogg Foundation also awarded a grant to City Harvest to initiate a strategic planning process with the NYC Office of SchoolFood with the goal of taking innovative pilots that increase participation in the school meals programs and bringing them to scale, in order to improve the quality and image of the food so that more kids will eat it.

The economy presented unanticipated challenges to raising food and funds, but City Harvest was in a strong position to take action. We've never before delivered so much food in a single year – this year's accomplishments were only possible because of the generosity of donors listed in this report and many thousands more. It is certain that future months will further test City Harvest's abilities, but with strong local support, we will be prepared for the challenges that lay on the road ahead.
